Best Run Mosque



Golden Mosque, Rochdale

The Golden Rochdale's Mosque, oldest and most cherished mosque, has been a central part of the local community since its establishment in 1963. Located on Lower Sheriff Street in Spotland, it was founded by local Muslims who united to create what has now become Rochdale's first and longest-standing mosque.


Aberdeen Mosque & Islamic Centre




Jamia Masjid Bilal




Ameenia Sultania Education Trust
