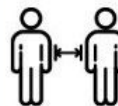

2 Meter distancing at all times, No hand shakes or hugging



Bring your own mat, upon this you will open your fast. No Communal eating.



Bring your own dried fruit (Dates) and bottled water only. No Food Distribution



Maghrib Salaah, Short Surah's and its preferred that sunnah prayed at home



Keep windows open and allow maximum fresh air to circulate



All worshippers must wear masks before they enter the Masjid. Volunteers and employees of masjid should be provided with PPE by masjid management. Welfare of everyone is paramount



Update masjid website and social media platforms with guidance and rules.

Look at booking system to control access - Track and Trace will still be active



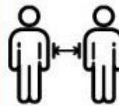
Security marshals are imperative. Recruit volunteers and paid personnel to manage entry and exit points, salah arrangements, checking PPE upon entry of all attendees of the masjid



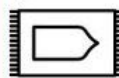

Tarawih

Same covid restriction apply for all salah's. Age restrictions, underlying health conditions, in/out protocols, all remain as in step 1

Short Surah's. The longer the prayer the higher the risk of infection inside.

Exit strategy for 8x 12x 20 Rakah Establish timings for multiple Jammats, have a booking system

Look at booking system to control access. Track and Trace will still be active



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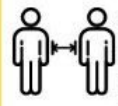


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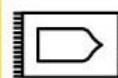
Donation/Collection points cleaned and money counted in secure manner with people in PPE

Eid

Plan prayers in & outside. Work with your local council and Police to prepare the Risk Assessment for outdoor eid payers



2 Meter distancing at all times, No hand shakes or hugging



Bring your own mat



No Food distribution



Short Surah's, & Short Khutba The longer the

prayer the higher the risk of infection inside. Outside events can be longer



Keep windows open and allow maximum fresh air to circulate



All worshippers must wear masks before they enter the Masjid. Outdoor events will require masks. Volunteers should be supplied with PPE by the management



Update masjid website and social media platforms with guidance and rules. Outdoor events need to be planned in advance and clear protocols of access presented



Security marshals are imperative. Recruit volunteers and paid personnel to managing entry and exit points, salah arrangements, checking PPE. Outdoor events will require liaising with local Police



Cleaning protocol clearly documented and responsibility shared. All touchpoints cleaned after each jamat. Donation/Collection points cleaned and money counted in secure manner with people in PPE

I'tikaf

I'tikaf services should be avoided. Maintaining a bubble in a public building will be very difficult. If management allows I'tikaf to restricted numbers, a quarantine system has to be established in the masjid, there can be no mixing with non I'tikaf worshippers



Every person has the responsibility to secure his/her belongings

Only pre packaged food can be delivered for individual I'tikaf members from family, Food cannot be shared in the bubble.

Mixing with worshippers outside of the I'tikaf bubble will increase risk of infection. If 1 member of the bubble is infected then the bubble has to break and self isolate. If they have to go home to do this the potential to infect home members is high and they have to isolate also.



Keeping where the I'tikaf bubble is located well ventilated is important



Bubble members should bring their own PPE. A negative (-) COVID test certificate from potential bubble members should be requested before entering the bubble in the masjid



Pre - registration and vetting system should be in place.

Masjid track and trace system should be in place before bubble is secured. Communication with bubble members via digital channels - no/limited face to face interaction



COVID Security is imperative to maintain a healthy covid secure bubble Security and Safety marshals need to support and direct I'tikaf bubble members in relation to access to non secure parts of the masjid



Cleaning protocol clearly documented and responsibility shared within the bubble members. All touchpoints cleaned after each jamat.
