Social distancing measures lifted. Jammah Saff can be established, maintain caution in crowded places

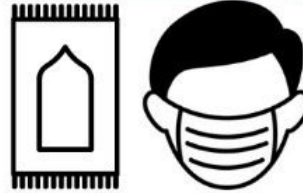


No number restrictions in Mosques. Entering and Exiting do not need to be controlled. Test & trace registration not required

Mosque Leadership should conduct and work within NEW Risk Assessment plans and guidelines

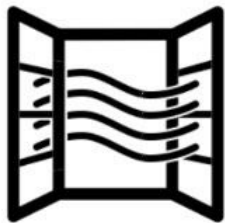


Leadership of Mosques could encourage Mask wearing inside but NOT mandatory. Personal musallah use should NOT be discouraged

Toilet and Wudu facilities access allowed. Cleaning scheduled reviewed
