- Youth engagement: Sports clubs, tutoring, and mentorship help young Muslims stay connected.
- Interfaith dialogue: Strong emphasis on building bridges with churches, synagogues, and civic groups.

The challenges that Mosques are facing today are one of security, inclusivity, delivering service that are required by the community they serve. My request is that all Mosques should work together and be inclusive whilst respecting the differences. We need to run our institutions professionally and not only rely on volunteers as governments will try to impose regulations. However, we should never compromise our beliefs.

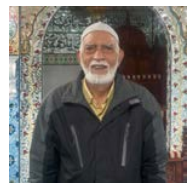
Mohammed Wasim – Jamiyat Tabligh Ul Islam (Southfield Square, Bradford)
